\$1,000 STUDENT LEADERSHIP AWARD

The American Optometric Association offers the Student Leadership Award to one third-year student at **each** North American school/college of optometry, including those at the Inter-American University of Puerto Rico, Université de Montréal and University of Waterloo. The \$1,000 USD award will be sent to the student's Financial Aid office to be applied to the recipient's tuition during the fall of the fourth year.

To be eligible for the AOA Student Leadership Award, a student must:

- Be a third-year student member in good standing in the American Optometric Student Association and the American Optometric Association;
- Have proven leadership roles and student government involvement (65%);
- Submit a one-page curriculum vita;
- Submit a brief statement, not to exceed two double-spaced pages, that reflects the value and/or learning experience that the applicant has gained from his or her leadership experience (35%);
- Be a student in good academic standing.

Check with your Student Affairs Office to determine your institution's on-campus application deadline. Applicants must submit materials (curriculum vitae and statements) to the Student Affairs Officer or designee by the school-established date. Each Student Affairs Officer or designee will choose a recipient from all applications received at the Student Affairs Office by the on-campus deadline and forward the individual's name to the AOA office in St. Louis by Monday, March 3, 2008.
