Vision disorders are prevalent and significant in preschool children. Most professional organizations concerned with the vision of children, including the American Academy of Ophthalmology, American Academy of Optometry, American Academy of Pediatric Ophthalmology and Strabismus, American Academy of Pediatrics, and the American Optometric Association recognize the need for early detection of vision disorders in preschool children aged 3 to 5 years. The Vision In Preschoolers research group is evaluating vision-screening tests designed to identify those children who would most benefit from an eye examination.
