



We are conducting an investigational medication study at The Ohio State University College of Optometry with individuals who have moderate to severe dry eye disease. The study involves an investigational eye drop medication which has not been approved by the FDA. Some participants will receive placebo; which is a sterile saline solution with no investigational medication in it.

DURATION:

This study will last up to 7 weeks. You will have up to 3 clinic visits and receive one telephone call from the study staff during this study. Below is the visit schedule.

Visit 1 (Screening Visit) ~ 3.5 hours

Visit 2 (7-10 days following Visit 1) ~ 2 hours

Telephone Contact (13-20 days from Visit 2) ~ 10 minutes. The study staff will contact you on the telephone to ask about your study medication use and to review any changes in your health (including any side effects) and medications since Visit 2.

Visit 3 (39-43 days from Visit 2) ~ 2.5 hours

All three visits will take place at The Ohio State University College of Optometry. You will receive \$100 for each completed study visit. If all three visits are completed you will receive \$300 total. Parking passes will be given if needed.
