Scientists at The Ohio State University College of Optometry are studying the *mechanisms and treatment of amblyopia*

Study 1: Amblyopia Mechanisms

What Will Happen

- Eligibility visit: Measurements will be taken using established clinical tests, similar to those used at your eye doctor's office, and customized computer testing
- If eligible, additional measurements using a non-invasive eye scanner (Optical Coherence Tomography), clinical, and computer-based procedures will be taken over 1-2 visits

Benefits

- Receive \$12/hour for the study visits described above
- Receive a parking pass, if required, for each visit

Study 2: Amblyopia Treatment

Besides the 2-3 visits for Study 1, individuals able to commit to multiple visits are invited to participate in a new computer videogame study to treat amblyopia

No Eye Patching Required!

What Will Happen

- You will have your vision trained using a computer program in a video game format
- You may also participate in traditional eye exercises that are used by optometrists during vision therapy
- To participate, you must be able to attend 20-40 visits of up to 2 hours each over a 6-8 weeks period

Benefits

- Receive \$10/visit
- Receive a parking pass, if required, for each visit
